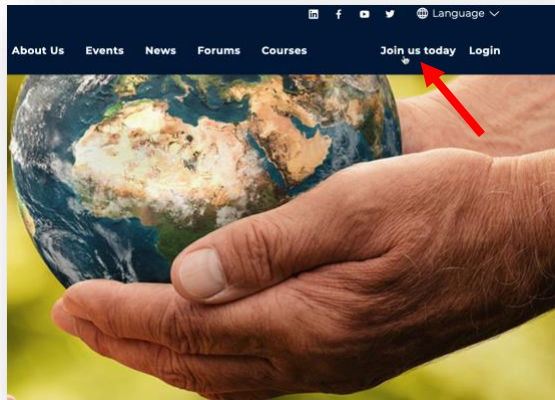

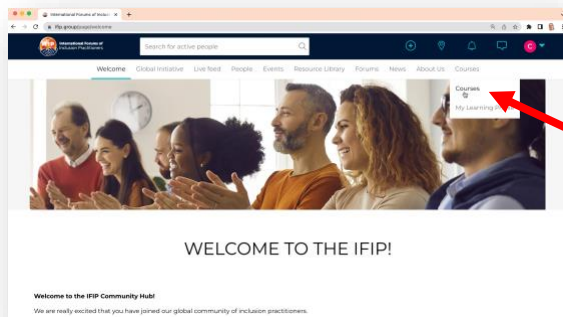

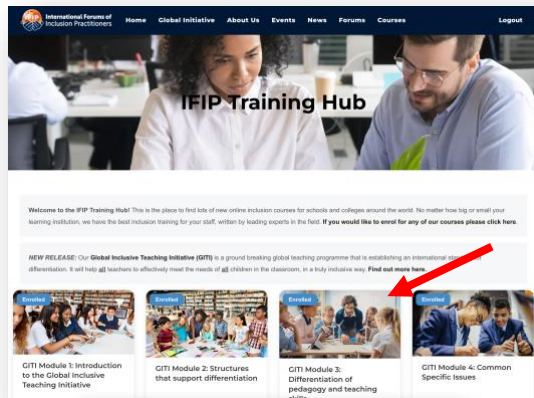
Complete your profile by adding your school details and the town where you live.

From the welcome page, click on the 'Courses' link, in the top right hand corner of the navigation bar. This will take you to the 'IFIP Training Hub' page.







Step 5.

Step 8.

Step 9.

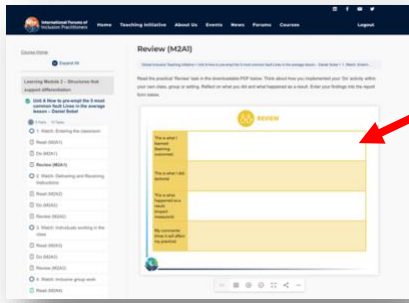

Step 10.

Type your response directly into the web form below the **'DO'** sections (see left.)

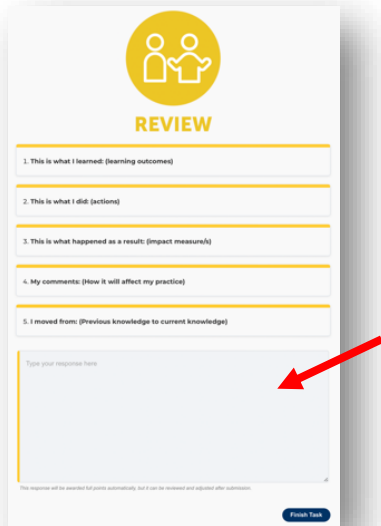
After this, click **'Finish Task'**, and then click on the blue **'Click here to continue'** button in the bottom right.

Progress

Points

As you complete each task the learning management system will award you points. These relate to your **coverage** of the whole course and not the content of your individual responses.
