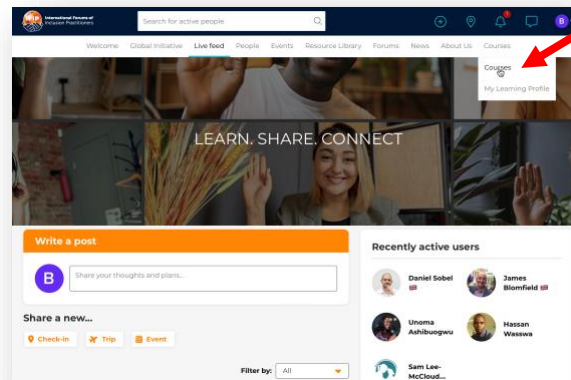


Getting started on GITI – Existing IFIP Members

Each part is made up of 4 tasks:

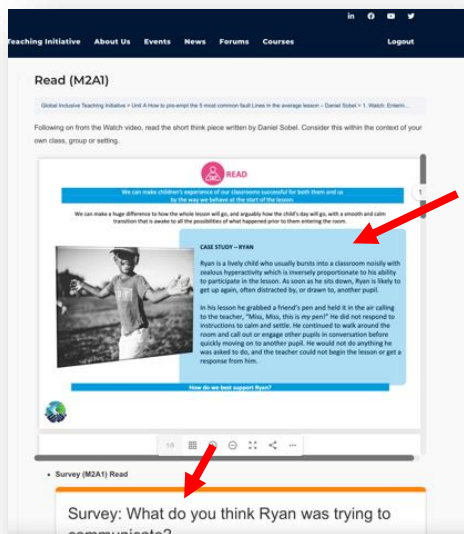
1. Watch

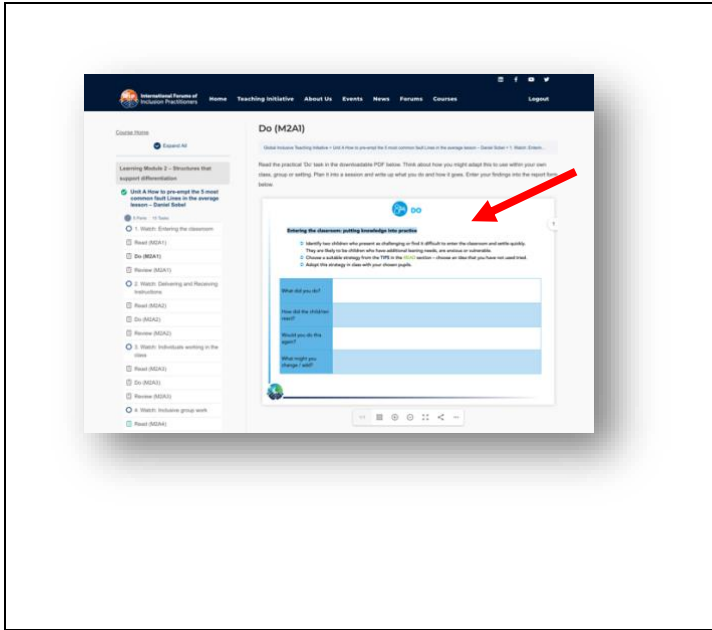
Step 8.

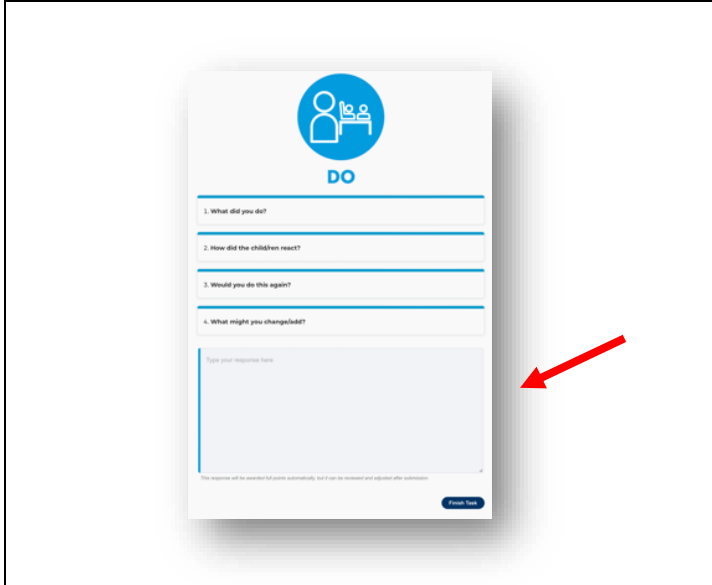

Step 9.

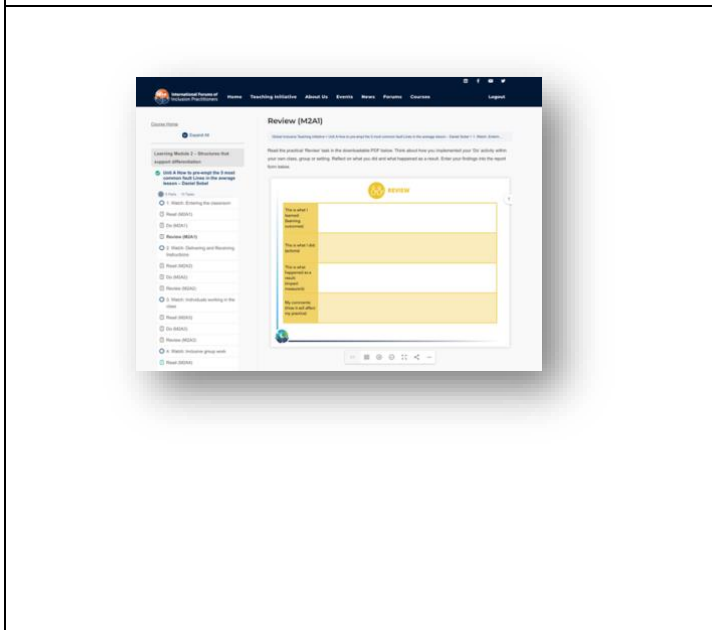
On the 'Do' page, you can scroll down to read all of the PDF or expand it. Teachers are asked to complete a practical task, adapting this to use within their own class, group or setting.

Type your response directly into the web form below the 'DO' sections (see left.)

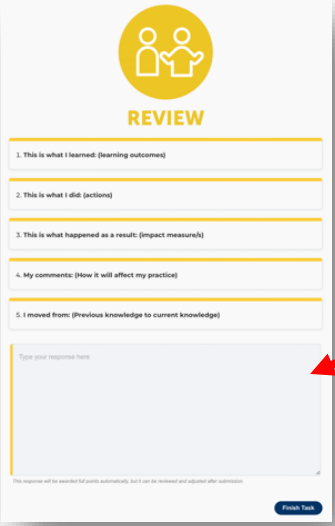
After this, click 'Finish Task', and then click on the blue 'Click here to continue' button in the bottom right.

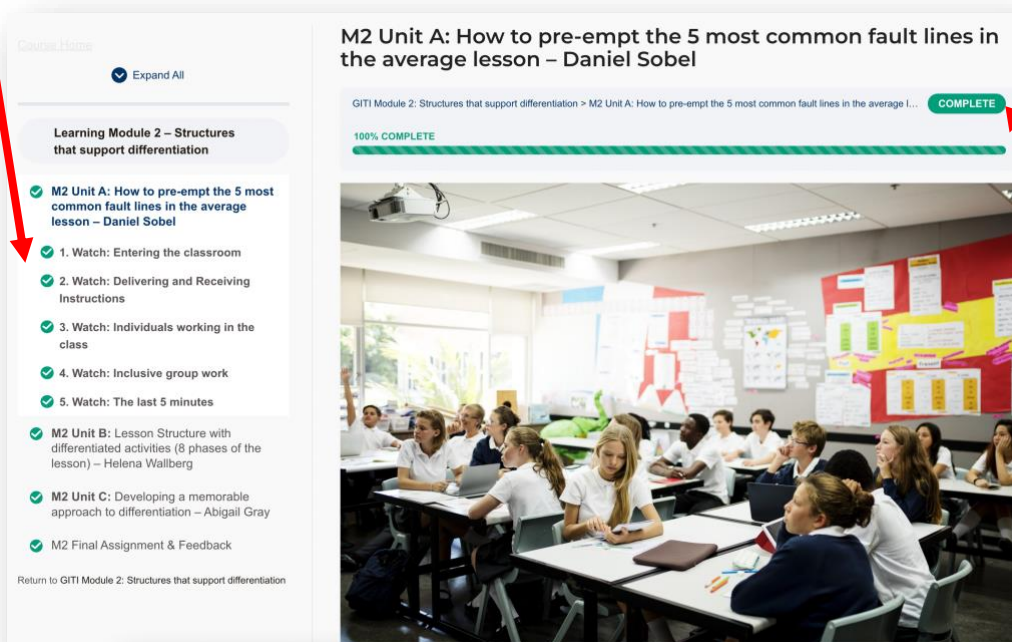
Step 12.
